

NATIONAL SKI PATROL
Mountain Travel and Rescue Level 1
Course #19386

What: Mountain Travel and Rescue (MTR) Level 1 course is an elective course for NSP patrollers that have an interest in becoming knowledgeable in backcountry travel and rescue procedures. This course is also open to the public with the same interests.

When: Saturday and Sunday, November 6-7, 2010

Where: Pat's Peak Henniker NH, patspeak.com

Time: 7:30 am November 6, 2010 – 5:00 pm November 7, 2010

Prerequisites: A desire to learn and have fun safely. You will be expected to read all Chapters with emphasis on 9, 10, 16, and 17 of the NSP MTR manual, which will be sent upon a paid registration. If you are not a member of the NSP it is recommended that you have taken a basic first aid or first responder course but it is not required.

Manuals: An NSP MTR manual is included in the cost of this course (see below) and will be mailed directly to your home. In order to receive a manual, you need to register and pay for the course. (See below) If you have already purchased a manual, 20 dollars will be deducted from course cost.

Logistics: Class will begin promptly at 8:00 am; we recommend that you plan on arriving at about 7:30-7:45 am. You will need to bring a notebook and a pen or pencil to take notes. Students should be prepared to **work through the lunch period** if needed. Student must bring all equipment and be prepared for **overnight camping** plus classes in the outdoor environment. Pack and inventory all personal and group equipment guided by the check list in the appendix of MTR manual (page 147). Final packing will be conducted during class. The class will go continuously until 5:00 pm on Sunday.

Cost: The cost of the course is **\$62.50 for NSP members and \$70.00 non-NSP, which includes the cost of the MTR manual.** Checks should be made out: Eric Zaharee. Check should be received not later than (NLT), **October 22, 2010**. Manuals will be sent out NLT, **October 26, 2010**.

Agenda: The MTR1 course is made up of 17 lesson topics. These lessons cover topics including Personal Survival, Travel, Back Country Considerations, and Search and Rescue skills. These are all reinforced with an **overnight camping** exercise and field exercises for Navigation, Technical Emergency Rescue Techniques, and Search and Rescue. Tentative schedule will be available one week prior to class to help you plan.

Pre-course: Please **BE SURE** to read Chapters 9, 10, 16, and 17 of the MTR manual before coming to class.
